| <b>Scotland's Rural College</b> | Veterinary Nursing, BSc (Hons)                       | Pass all units and BBB student profile | <p>Aberdeen and Barony. <b>Highly competitive degree and interview required.</b> A minimum of 140 hours (four weeks) of experience in a veterinary practice is required prior to application, which you need to show evidence of at interview. Other Veterinary Nursing courses are noted below.</p> <p>Veterinary Nursing Level 3 Diploma available at Oatridge. This is a work-based qualification with theory learning at SRUC which requires you to be employed as a student veterinary nurse in a RCVS approved practice.</p> <p>A Veterinary Nursing PDA is available at Aberdeen. This is a twelve-week distance learning course that offers those considering an application to the BSc/BSc (Hons) Veterinary Nursing degree an opportunity to improve the quality of their application and gain valuable personal and academic skills.</p> |
